The Southern Tier Paramedic Program (STPP) is a joint venture of Lourdes Hospital and SUNY Broome Community College (BCC) in cooperation with the other regional hospitals and EMS agencies.

STPP's mission is to provide the community with outstanding paramedics in a timely and affordable manner. The STPP adheres to the National Paramedic Educational Standards. BCC's excellent facilities and student support services enhance a student's learning experience and success. Financial aid is available to qualified students.

Primary Track (2 year) paramedic students, meeting learning objectives may be eligible to sit for the NYS Critical Care Technician (CCT) exam at the conclusion of their first year and NYS Paramedic Exam at the conclusion of the second year.

The EMT-CCT to Paramedic Advanced Standing Track has several prerequisites. Among them are:

- Successful completion of human anatomy & physiology (A&P) equivalent of BIO 131 and 132. Ideally, prior to PMD course work but A&P can be taken concurrently.
- Submission of **50** ALS PCR's for which the prospective student was in-change; with at least 25 in the last 12 mo.
- Demonstrated ALS knowledge & skill proficiency.
- Submission of a letter of recommendation from each ALS agency Medical Director which the EMT-CC is a member.
- Agree to take PMD 211 – 214 final exams prior to the start of each PMD class.
