

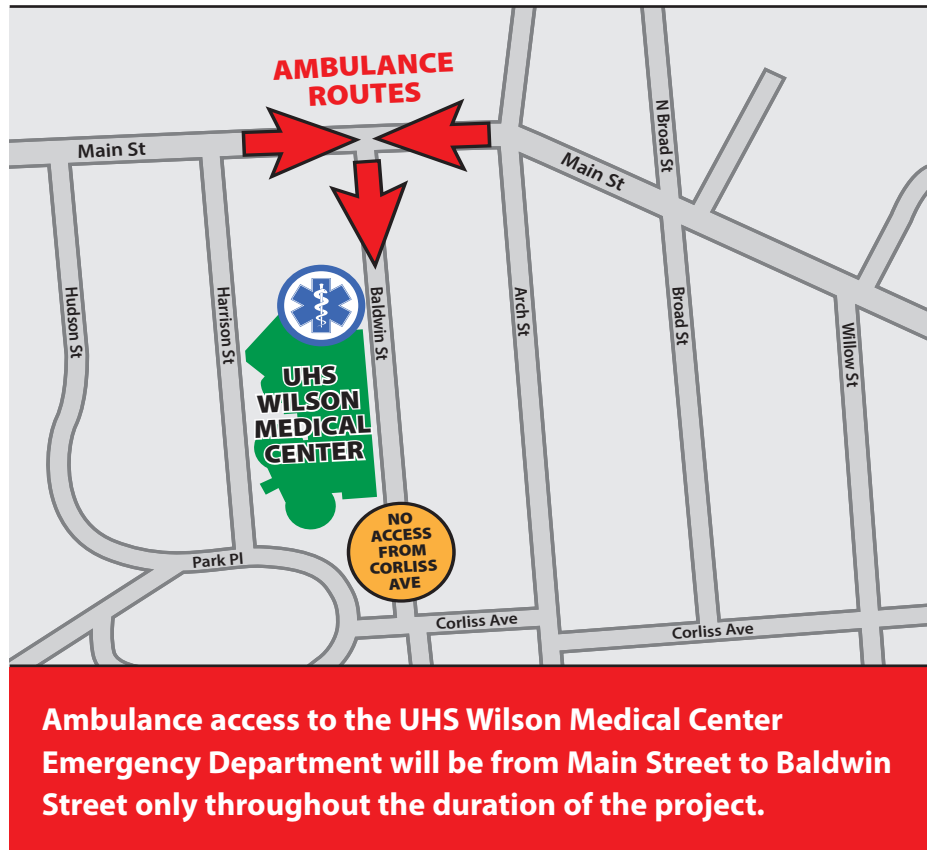

UHS Wilson Medical Center Emergency Department access will be maintained during Baldwin Street project

A two-month project on Baldwin Street to upgrade water service to the UHS Wilson Medical Center campus and the Village of Johnson City will begin on April 9. The scope of the project will include replacing the main water line and repaving the street. Traffic patterns will change during the work, but access to the Emergency Department entrance will be maintained at all times.

Ambulance access to the UHS Wilson Medical Center Emergency Department will be from Main Street to Baldwin Street only throughout the duration of the project.

The water main replacement is a collaboration between UHS and the Village of Johnson City. The planned work is weather-permitting.
